9.3.3 (d) Village Center District

- (v) Special uses. Buildings with a footprint of more than 1,5008,500 square feet; two three or more residential units, commercial units or buildings, whether attached or detached, which have a total footprint of more than 18,500 square feet; or one or more multi-family buildings are located on a single parcel of property or on contiguous parcels owned by the same owner and are developed over a period of two years.
- (vi) Development Standards.
 - 1) Structure size standards. New structures in the Village Center District shall not exceed a footprint of 48,500 square feet unless approved as a special use in accordance with the provisions set forth in Section 3.7.15.
 - 6) Height standard. The maximum height in the Village Center District shall be 30-45 feet.
 - 11) Maximum Floor Area Ratio- The maximum Floor Area Ratio (FAR) is 1.5.

 - Buildings with a footprint of more than 48,500 square feet; or two_three_or more commercial units or buildings, whether attached or detached, which have a total footprint of more than 84,500 square feet, or one or more multifamily buildings are located on a single parcel of property or on contiguous parcels owned by the same owner and are developed over a period of two years.
- 9) Development standards.
 - f) Height standard. The maximum height in the General Commercial District shall be $\frac{30}{45}$ feet.
- 11) Maximum Floor Area Ratio- The maximum Floor Area Ratio (FAR) is 1.5.
